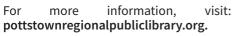


The library has earned Gold Star status in the PA Forward Star Program, the highest level a library can achieve. This recognition means the library consistently offers strong programs and services that build key skills in reading, information

use, civic engagement, health, and financial decision making. For the community, the Gold Star signals a trusted, high quality library that is deeply committed to helping residents learn, thrive, and fully participate in daily life. The library is also dedicated to serving multilingual and diverse communities and remains a safe, inclusive space where everyone can feel respected, informed, and connected to the wider Pottstown area.

Through its **Wellness on Our Minds initiative**, the library focused on promoting equitable community health, encouraging mental wellness, and improving access to important information. This project expanded the collection with **more**

than 180 new books centered on mental and physical health, meeting a clear and growing need among patrons. The initiative also included a Mental Health and Wellness Festival, wellness kits filled with information on local services and upcoming programs, and a new Interactive Language Assistant that helps staff better serve patrons who do not speak English as their primary language.
