Community Health & Dental Care (CHDC) is a nonprofit, federally qualified health center dedicated to providing comprehensive, affordable healthcare to individuals and families whether insured, uninsured, or underinsured across Montgomery, Berks, and Chester counties.

Through its Open Access Program, CHDC provides same-day and next-day appointments, allowing patients to receive timely care when they need it most. The organization also integrates scheduling across multiple services, enabling patients to address various healthcare needs in a single visit—reducing both time and transportation barriers.

- Medication-Assisted Treatment

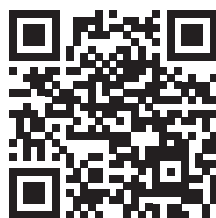
Founded in 2008 with support from the Pottstown Area Health & Wellness Foundation (PAHWF) and other local businesses, CHDC has grown from serving 39 patients in their first three days to serving over 25,000 active patients, adding new locations and services to meet rising needs. What began as a small operation now serves thousands of individuals across multiple sites including North Coventry, Lower Pottsgrove, Barto, and most recently Boyertown.
