Mission Kids Child Advocacy Center offers a compassionate and collaborative response to children who have experienced abuse. In cooperation with Creative Health Services, Mission Kids recently opened a new office located at 929 Willow Street in Pottstown. Their mission is to ensure justice for child victims through comprehensive support, reducing trauma, and providing a clear path toward healing. By creating a child-friendly environment and working closely with law enforcement, child protective services, and medical professionals, Mission Kids minimizes the emotional toll on children during the investigative process.

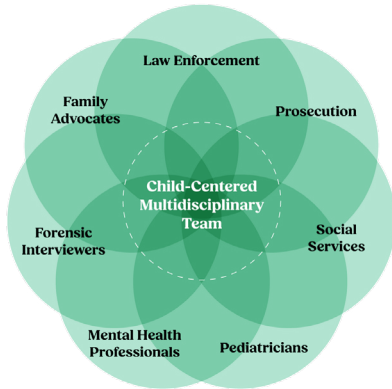
Mission Kids Child Advocacy Center focuses on three key areas to be successful:

Helping Kids Heal

Education & Prevention

Ignighting Change

Through trauma-informed forensic interviews and specialized therapy services, Mission Kids ensures children receive the care they need to recover and build resilience. In 2024, the center served 269 child clients, including 157 new cases. Remarkably, 100% of the children who received therapy reported a reduction in trauma symptoms.



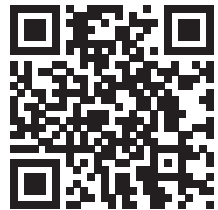
In addition to direct services, Mission Kids offers training and workshops for schools, caregivers, and community organizations to raise awareness and prevent child abuse. These programs equip adults with the knowledge and skills needed to recognize and respond to signs of abuse.

Mission Kids advocates for stronger policies that protect children and improve responses to abuse. By working closely with lawmakers, they help shape legislation aimed at creating lasting change in the fight against child abuse.

The impact of Mission Kids is evident in the thousands of children and families they have supported. With continued community collaboration, they remain a vital source of healing and advocacy for those affected by abuse, helping to guide them toward recovery and justice.
